The Cumberland County Paralegal Association

held a bake sale at the Cumberland County Courthouse last year, collecting \$570 in proceeds. The money was used to provide teddy bears in support of the Cumberland County Sheriff's Department's "Teddy Bears for Kids" program. The program aims to reduce the psychological trauma experienced by young children who are victims of accidents, crimes or happen to be at the scene of an investigation. Responding officers give distressed children a teddy bear in an attempt to soothe them. Through the fundraiser, CCPA was able to provide 100 huggable bears to the Sheriff's

Department. In addition, CCPA made donations to scholarships for students at Fayetteville Technical Community College, sent packages to troops overseas, collected donations to support Second Harvest Food Bank and gave \$250 donations to the Ronald McDonald House and the Veterans Administration in 2009.
